

To explore the differences between
Analogue and Digital
methods of mark-making

Their Techniques, Physical Tools,
and the affect on thinking processes

Two activities:

- using a pencil (Analogue) to make a line on a piece of paper, and quick sketch of your pencil
- using a stylus (Digital) to make a line and sketch of the stylus on an iPad with a stylus and / or a Laptop with a Tablet and Stylus

Try to vary your line, thin and thick etc, to find the qualities of the particular pencil / stylus

Process, not the Result

This exercise is not about
your quality of drawing!

It is to compare and reflect on two ways
of making marks – how they feel to use,
their physical characteristics and
the kinds of marks they make.

Process, not the Result

Finally we will reflect on how this
might affect the recording and visualisation
of our thinking process

Analogue and Digital
